Any additional race is **\$15.00** (a separate SAR must be submitted for each event entered). There is a late fee of \$5.00 for all race day registration. Unattached riders (except Men 5 and Women 4) will be assessed a \$3.00 surcharge (support your local bike club!). Please do not request refunds.
